Alberto Escamilla Resume

A professional artist since 1978, I am one of the leading Impressionist painters in the El Paso border region. I worked part time as an art instructor at Father Yermo High School for 13 years, 1987 to 2000.

Several years into my career, I began an in-depth study of the lives and works of the European Masters, especially those of the French Impressionists, or the "Independents" as they preferred to be called. Because I felt such a strong connection with the way these artists believed and painted, I focused on mastering their techniques. From this point forward, my work entered a new dimension which gave rise to my own experimentation with color.

The landscapes and gardens I paint emphasize a strong understanding of color. Objects remain the same, but as the light of the day changes, so do the colors used to portray them. My technique involves giving priority to color, allowing the color to evoke the form rather than form dictating color.

Using small brushes and taps of paint on the canvas, I continually work on mastering the blending of colors. My use of definitive brushstrokes and my choice of subject matter replicate the impressionistic style which offers the viewer a sense of beauty and tranquility of God's world.

Following the versatility of the "Independents", I paint a variety of subjects. I may choose to portray ballerinas in the style of Degas, or like Monet, who produced numerous paintings of his gardens, I find simple beauty in the familiar cotton fields in El Paso's Upper and Lower Valleys or the bluebonnets of central and east Texas. I consider landscapes as my specialty as this is my favorite subject.

My work can be found in numerous **collections** throughout the United States, in Mexico, Canada, Italy, Germany, Spain, England, Australia, Austria, South Korea, Japan, France and numerous corporations and collectors, i.e. Casa Ford Dealership, River Oaks; James Dick (Viva auto dealerships), Dr. Thomas and Ruth Pester, Dr. Mark Gallardo, Ana Hunt, Dr. Linda Lacy, Caspar Art Collection (Dr. Peter Schnabl, Vienna, Austria); Gussman collection at the Philbrook Museum of Art, Tulsa, Oklahoma; Cormac McCarthy (Author & Pulitzer Prize Winner), & others.

An award-winning artist, I was inducted into the El Paso Artist Hall of Fame, October 22, 2004. A bronze plaque bust of me is on permanent display in the "Hall of Fame Gallery" at the International Museum of Art in El Paso, Texas. I was a finalist for the Texas State Artist for 2010. I was the exclusive International de la Zarzuela poster artist for eight years.
